Dear Travel Agent,

Enclosed is a dossier, compliments of Great Barrier Airlines Limited, of Tourist accommodation, rental car, taxi and activities on the Great Barrier Island.

G.B.A. commenced operation on December 2, 1983 and provide an all year round scheduled airline service for the Barrier. A minimum of two schedules are operated daily between Auckland and the Island increasing to flights every two hours during peak and holiday periods. A minimum twice weekly service is also operated between Tauranga-Pauanui and the Barrier.

Commencing in December 1986 we will be operating a Waiheke Island Air Ferry service with a minimum of four services daily between Auckland and Waiheke Island. Some Barrier Island flights are scheduled through Waiheke Island, Great Barrier Island connection. G.B.A's Auckland terminal is Auckland Airport at Mangere where we have counter facilities in the Domestic terminal. Barrier services are operated in and out of the Islands, two airfields, Claris, the main airport and Okiwi in the north. On the mainland a pick-up, drop-off stop is flown through Ardmore airfield, the general aviation field in South Auckland. Preference is for passengers to depart and arrive at Auckland Airfield.

On the Barrier Island G.B.A. provides FREE "AIRPORTER" mini bus transfer to/from both Airfields to all lodges, motels and Guest houses as well as to the main settlement areas of Tryphena, Whangaparapara and Port FitzRoy. G.B.A's service is a complete Air and ground package and we have 24 seats available on each service flight.

G.B.A. is owned and operated by Professional Airline Pilots. The Managing Director is an ex Jumbo jet 747 pilot, a director currently flying for the company is jet rated and the other two directors are present Jumbo Jet 747 pilots flying Air New Zealand's International Air Routes. With this Professional management G.B.A. air service is second to none for safety, reliability and consideration to its passengers.

The Great Barrier Island is a new discovery destination. The Island is very primitive, there is no electric power supply, individual diesel generators are used, the roads are one way clay and metal tracks and the manual phone system dates back to the 1930's. There are magnificent beaches particularly on the Island's East Coast and very good forestry walks with well equipped huts for accommodation. The Lodges and Guest houses are of varying standards but all are clean and provide excellent meals. There are three tour operators; Safari Tours in Tryphena, Scenic Tours in Claris and Aotea Tours at Port FitzRoy. At present two commercial boat operators are offering boat and dive trips, day or overnight. Aotea Tours, Tryphena and Great Barrier Charters in Port FitzRoy. As you will see in the brochure rental cars and motor cycles as well as taxi services are available. There is no public transport at present on the Island except for G.B.A's Airporter transfer buses, however a public bus service may soon be commenced.

In the main the Island is warmer than the mainland, particularly on the East Coast. There are no hotels on the Island, however a Club is situated in Tryphena which has full bar facilities and an evening meal service. Most Lodges accept casual guests for meals and wine etc. is usually available. A wine shop is situated at Mulberry Grove, Tryphena Harbour and there are four Island shops.

I trust this and the following information will assist you with your bookings for the Barrier.

G.B.A. accepts all travel agents' vouchers for airfares less 5% commission and complete tour packages are available in conjunction with the N.Z. Adventure Centre in Victoria Park Market, Auckland. Phone 399-192 or 399-194. A/H 489-817. P.O. Box 72068, Auckland 9 or Telex KZ63091.

G.B.A. provides a 24 hour booking service and booking may be made by phoning collect. We prefer bookings to be made during normal office hours wherever possible.

The Natural Forest Park ranger service, with tracks and planned walks is only 10 minutes from the Lodge.

Tryphena Harbour is situated at the Southern end of Great Barrier Island and faces the Coromandel Ranges.

A feature of this extremely beautiful harbour is the crystal clear water which allows the bottom to be seen from a depth of twenty feet or more.

From the barge ramp at Puriri Bay, the entire harbour is skirted by a scenic road which provides a pleasant four-and-a-half mile walk or dive and ends at the wharf at Shoal Bay.

Glorious white sandy beaches, shaded by Pohutukawas are to be found at the head of the bay, which are ideal for picnicking and swimming and are safe for small children.

Tryphena can be used as a base for many scenic, picnic, swimming and tramping activities.

For instance the old gold and silver mines at Whangaparapara are well worth a visit as are the hot pools which are reached by an interesting bush walk.

Rock hounds will be well satisfied with a sortie to Okupu and the East Coast usually provides good surfing for the more active swimmer.

Tipi and Bob's Holiday Lodge is situated on the water's edge of Tryphena Harbour, from which a magnificent panorama of this boaters' haven is gained, and it is not uncommon to see Dolphins at play from the lounge windows.

Each guest room opens onto the sun deck where the paper may be read or mail written, if you can tear your eyes away from the unsurpassed beauty of this holiday spot.

There is also a self-contained cottage which is let daily or weekly.

Bob is a professional fisherman who knows where the big ones are to be caught, so if fishing is your forte the launch is sometimes available when Bob is not at sea. Dinghy and outboard are also available.

# Great Barrier Forest

Situated in the central massif area of the island, Great Barrier Forest has a total area of 7,900 ha.

The topography is steep, rugged and very much dissected by streams. Mt Hirakimata (Hobson) 621m, (2,038ft) is the principal point from which the main streams originate.

These are the Kaiarara, Awaana and Kaitoke. Other streams (Kiwiriki, Coffins and Wairahi) originate from the chain of rhyolitic ridges that extend south of Mt Hobson.

Prior to the Forest Service Administration, the entire forest had been logged for kauri, portions dug over for kauri gum, and the Whitecliffs area mined for gold and silver.

The first trees were felled in 1794 when the British Navy removed kauri from the Kaiarara for spars.

The total quantity of kauri taken out from Great Barrier Island is estimated to have exceeded 100 million feet log measure.

Fires have added to the destruction of bush areas. In 1887 a fire starting in the Kaitoke region swept north through

Fires have added to the destruction of bush areas. In 1887 a fire starting in the Kaitoke region swept north through the headwater of the Awana Stream and burned for three months. In 1911 a large fire ran riot on the southern slopes of the Upper Kaiarara Basin.


The only introduced animals in the forest were goats, pigs and rabbits. Captain Cook liberated the first goats on the northern tip of the island.

Today the forest is a Kauri Management /Research unit with areas set aside for sanctuaries and recreation. Improvements by releasing from nurse crop T. tree of naturally regenerating kauri stands is supplemented by an annual planting of 5,000 kauri seedlings in areas devoid of regeneration.

Trampers huts at the Kaiarara Creek and Whangaparapara cater for a variety of visitors, school children and youth groups. Maintaining the 121 kilometres of walking tracks which cross the rough terrain is a continuous job.

Pools have been formed and toilets installed at the Kaitoke Hot Springs and the 'Green' camp mine site at Whangaparapara. The NZFS launch "Aotea" maintains a fire-information-assistance patrol during the summer (fire) season to the every increasing boating fraternity.
